Target audience:

Course Aims:

By the end of the course participants will have the ability to apply the knowledge they have gained to improve current health and safety practices

The course is aimed at all workplaces where employees are exposed to vibration & noise through plant and processes. All levels of staff will benefit. For managers and Supervisors, it emphasises the need for controlling exposure to vibration & noise. For operatives, it emphasises their contribution to controlling exposure to vibration
